REFUGEE INTEGRATION PROJECT TAKING A CENTRE-STAGE ROLE AGAIN - 1ST EDITION_2018

OBJECTIVE

This joint Bilingualism and Foreign Languages Office and Lifelong Learning Office of the Italian Culture Section of the Autonomous Province of Bolzano project created by the CLS, in conjunction with Teatro Stabile and with the support of Formazione Professionale Italiana, is intended to put forward a shared action plan designed to foster the socio-economic and cultural integration of third country nations applying for asylum here.



Specifically the focus is promoting the interpersonal network on a territorial level as well as services designed to improve the autonomy levels of these individuals, improving their language and individual skills and raising their awareness of their own skills, thereby fostering positive and autonomous social integration.

Many asylum seekers have professional experience and specific skills and educational backgrounds. Too often these cultural and

professional pasts are wiped out and their labour market experiences are well below their skills, a great loss of professional resources for the society they settle in. The objective of this project is to supply suitable opportunities for them, offering them a rich and variegated experience trajectory.
