# THE WORLD FAIR OF NATURAL GAS AND HYDROGEN VEHICLES A VEHICLE EXHIBITION MILESTONE

ENGVA, in partnership with the Gas Vehicles Report (GVR) has created a 7000 m² exhibition that should be the largest display to date (and test drive) of gaseous fuel vehicles – natural gas and hydrogen – throughout Europe. *The World Fair of Natural Gas and Hydrogen Vehicles* runs concurrently with the ENGVA conference and throughout the weekend on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> June. The Exhibition provides a commercial forum for European vehicle manufacturers of NGVs and hydrogen vehicles to show their newest technologies, providing a virtual marketplace and sales opportunity to the visitors from the surrounding region, European and other countries worldwide. Members of the general public are invited to join the exhibition during its four day opening so that they can view – and in some cases *drive* – the latest NGV and hydrogen technologies available *today*!

# Half Day Tour of Bolzano WEDNESDAY, 8<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2005

(Meet in Lobby of Four Points Sheraton 09:15; Return ~15:00) (Exact return time depends on local conditions.)

Bolzano is a compact town with beautiful mountain views and passages filled with cafés and a variety of high quality fashion and crafts for sale. A leisurely walking tour of Bolzano will provide an overview and highlights of the town's historic sites. After taking a 20 minute ride into the mountains on a cable car, participants will have lunch at The Holzner Hotel, the first in Bolzano and frequented by European royalty and VIPs. Following lunch, participants will take a 45 minute round trip tour of the Crown of the Dolomites in a special, 120 year old historical train (normally reserved for special guests of the Province). Participants then will return by cable car and everyone will be taken back to town centre after lunch. (Transportation also will be provided back to the Four Points Sheraton.)

# Full Day Tour The City of Merano & The Gardens of Trauttmansdorff Castle THURSDAY, 9<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2005

(Meet in Lobby of Four Points Sheraton 09:00; Return ~16:30) (Exact return time depends on local conditions.)

Once a fortified Medieval town, Merano today is known for its health spas, architectural beauty, and shopping. Merano is filled with elegant buildings, many representative of the Liberty style, and beautiful parks and gardens that make this town one of the gems of the Alpine region. In the 16<sup>th</sup> century Tyrolean nobility chose to build their sumptuous residences here. In the 19<sup>th</sup> century a group of local doctors proposed Merano develop as a health spa and it became among the most popular resorts in Central Europe. The Kurhaus, a magnificent example of Liberty-style architecture was built in 1914 and today is used for concerts, conferences and exhibitions.

Participants will be taken to Merano by coach (about 30 minutes drive from Bolzano) to tour the town centre and some of the most significant sites. Time will be left to wander the old promenades and the Via dei Portici where the best of regional and European goods are sold. Following lunch in one of Merano's fashionable eateries participants will be taken to Trauttmansdorff Castle part way between Merano and Bolzano for a visit to their famous gardens. The Gardens of Trauttmansdorff Castle present a variety of environments, including the Japanese Garden, water and terraced gardens, orchid house, olive groves and dessert cacti. Visitors can stroll through the gardens at their leisure (audio tours are available) and even stop at the small café overlooking the lily pond.
